STATEMENT OF INTENT

From the outset I wish to indicate that all at Dale College will do everything in their power to ensure the following:

- Smooth running of all fixtures
- Safety of Players; Officials; Spectators
- Building the camaraderie and 'gees' and rivalry between our schools


With this in mind, we plan the following:

- 1 The Malcom Andrew Sports Centre (MASC) closed to ALL until after the 1st XV match.
The MASC will be dedicated to hosting the Queens College (QC) Staff and Officials; as well as Dale College (DC) Staff and official's.
 - Hosting at the MASC: Tea / coffee and lunch
Also after-match function
 - Balcony and seating area cordoned off for Staff
 - Dedicated host at this venue
- 2 Security
 - Restricted parking on grounds; tickets only.
 - Searching of spectators through controlled entrance gates.
 - Visible policing: using trainees from Bhisho. Contact has already been made with the Trainee Unit in this regard.
 - Adjustment to seating with the mobile stands set further back.
 - Technical area on the half-way line – clearly demarcated for both sides
 - Set up advertising boards and wedges behind the dead ball line on both sides of the field
 - Start the 1st XV match at 14:00
 - Cover the clock (No time indicated for any match)
 - The match referee to be approved by both sides. (Welcome nominations from Queens)

- 3 The Coaches and Players will be educated in the manner of:
- Not playing (benching) for a lower team.
 - Playing in the correct age group.
 - All team lists using SASAMS and BOKSMART to be sent by the Thursday prior to the match.
 - No players from outside Dale College; only bona fide Dalians in each team.
 - Stress the on-going history between our schools.
 - Not long ago, Mr Harker arranged through the switching of venues; for Queens to host Dale at Queens 150th in 2008. Dale in turn hosted Queens at Dale's 150th in 2011.
- 4 The Old Boys Branches will be brought on board and encouraged to respect the traditions, ethos and history of our two great Schools and to avoid jeopardizing the relationship.
- 5 All aspects to the build-up to the fixture will be stressed in the classroom; corridors; playing areas; assemblies.

I stress the commitment of Dale College to ensuring a fine Derby Fixture between our Schools.
